
## How To Send Text Messages to Natural Networks Softphone User

Step#	Task
1	Login to Your Extension in the Softphone Web Client.
	If you are not aware of how to access your Softphone Web Client, then resend your email credentials by Clicking the Settings Gear Icon at the bottom right corner of your 3CX Softphone desktop app. Then choose Resend Credentials in the settings list.

2	After clicking to Resend Credentials, you will receive an email from <b>Natural Networks CloudPBX</b> with your login information.
	Scrool down in the email message to Using The CloudPBX WebClient section.
	Here you will find the website to go to as well as your extension and password. Click the link to open your extensions <b>Web Interface</b> , followed by your extension and password, then choose <b>Login</b> .
3	Upon logging into the web interface you will find the <b>Chat</b> option on the left hand side menu.  Left-click the chat menu option to be taken to the Chat window. Then select the + symbol from the top-left corner
	and select Send SMS Message
	and select Send SMS Message

	number of the person you wish to send the text message to, then select the <b>Start Chat</b> button on the right.
5	You can type your message at the bottom and then press the Enter key, or left-click the send button.
6	If you would like to send an <b>image</b> , select the <b>paper clip</b> icon in the bottom-right corner of the chat window, then find the image you want to send and select <b>Open</b> .  A new window will open displaying the image. If you would like to send the image, select <b>Send</b> from the top-right corner.



8	You can continue to chat with the mobile phone user's within the 3CX Dektop Application as well.  Please note that regular text messages will continue to work through the desktop application, however pictures will not work unless sent inside of the web based client window.
9	When you are finished with the web client, you can exit by selecting the personal Avatar image in the <b>top-left corner</b> , and selecting <b>Exit Client</b> .  You may then <b>close</b> the browser window or tab at this time.
