Syncing Outlook 2003 sent folder with IMAP

When setting up Outlook 2003 with IMAP, the local sent folder does not automatically get synced with the IMAP sent folder. This is a feature that was added in Outlook 2007. To sync Outlook 2003's sent box with IMAP you have to create a rule.

Create a Rule with the Rules Wizard

- 1. On the **Tools** menu, click **Rules Wizard**, and then click **New**.
- 2. Click to select "Check messages after sending", and then click Next.
- 3. Click to select "uses the *form name* form check box".
- 4. Click the underlined **form name** in the **Rule Description** box.
- 5. In the **Standard Forms Library**, click to select **Message** and then click **Open**. Click **Next**, and **Next** again.
- 6. Click to select the "Move a copy to the specified folder" check box.
- 7. Click to select a "specified" folder in the **Rule Description** box
- 8. Click to select or create a folder on your IMAP server. Click **OK**, and then click **Next**.
- 9. Click **Next** again, and then specify a rule name. Click **Finish**.
