




Allow access to Last Pass from outside the US

#	Instructions	Details
1	Go to LastPass Admin Center “Manage Companies” and at the end of the client’s account name click “Manage company”	
2	Go to “Policies” at the top of the page	
3	Under “General Policies” enter the search term “Country”. The “Restrict access by country” policy will be returned.	
4	Click on the name of the policy to edit. Where it says “All users” Edit policy users.
