

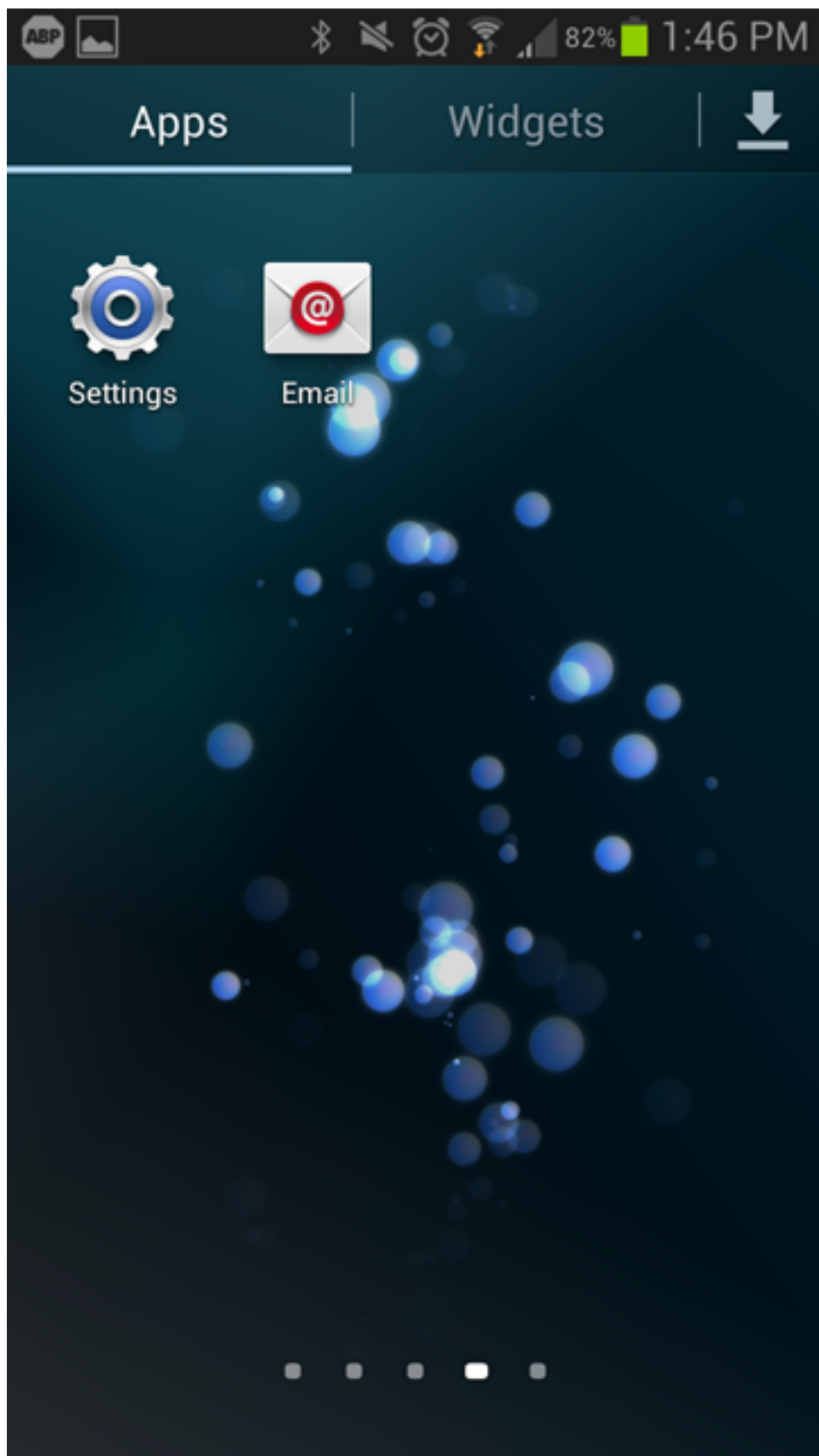
# How to configure an Android phone using IMAP

This article explain show to configure an Android smartphone with an IMAP e-mail account. This process is simple and should only take a few minutes.

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1. Open the **"Email"** application, accessible via the <spanstyle="font-weight: bold;"="">Apps menu from the home screen.

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2. Once the "**Email**" app has opened, enter your full <spanstyle="font-weight: bold;"="">e-mail and **password**, then clickÂ **Manual Setup**.

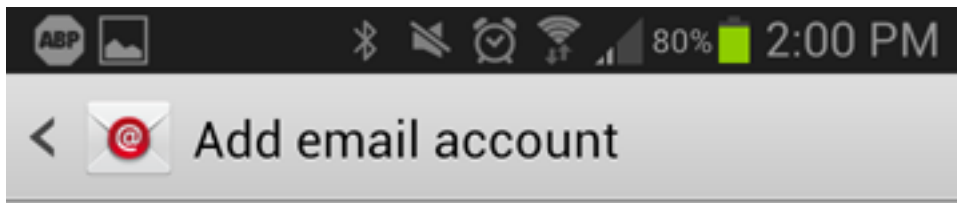

3. Choose **IMAP** as the account type.

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What type of account?

POP3 account

IMAP account

Microsoft Exchange ActiveSync

4. Fill out the settings completely as follows:

- **User name:** Your complete e-mail address.
- **Password:** Your password for the corresponding e-mail address.
- **IMAP Server:** imap.COMPANY.COM  
(COMPANY.COM should be replaced with the portion of your e-mail address following the "@" symbol. Example: if your e-mail address is HanSolo@MFalcon.biz, then your IMAP server should be imap.MFalcon.biz)
- **Security Type:** None
- **Port:** 143
- **IMAP path prefix:** Leave Blank

When finished, click **next**.

5. Fill out the settings completely as follows:

- **SMTP Server:** smtp.COMPANY.COM  
(COMPANY.COM should be replaced with the portion of your e-mail address following the "@" symbol. Example: if your e-mail address is HanSolo@MFalcon.biz, then your POP3 server should be pop3.MFalcon.biz)
- **Security type:** None
- **Port:** 587
- **User name:** Your complete e-mail address.
- **Password:** Your password for the corresponding e-mail address.

When finished, click **next**.
