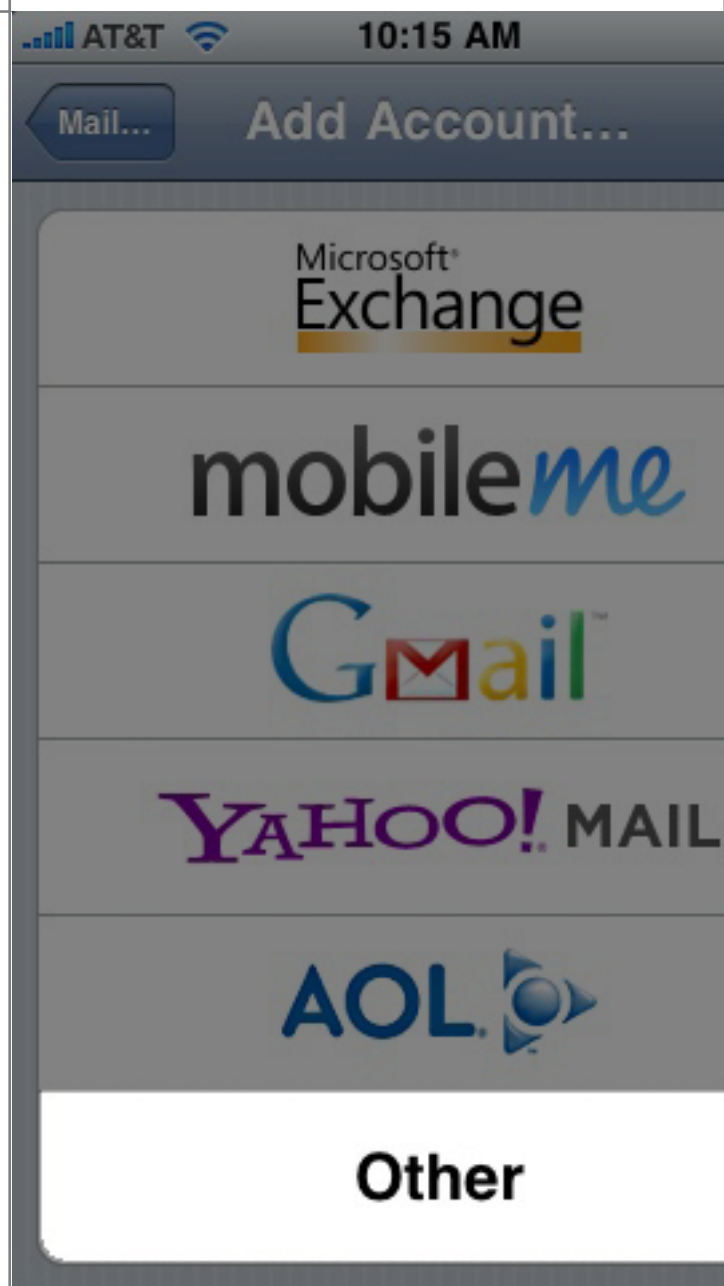
## How to Configure an iPhone using IMAP

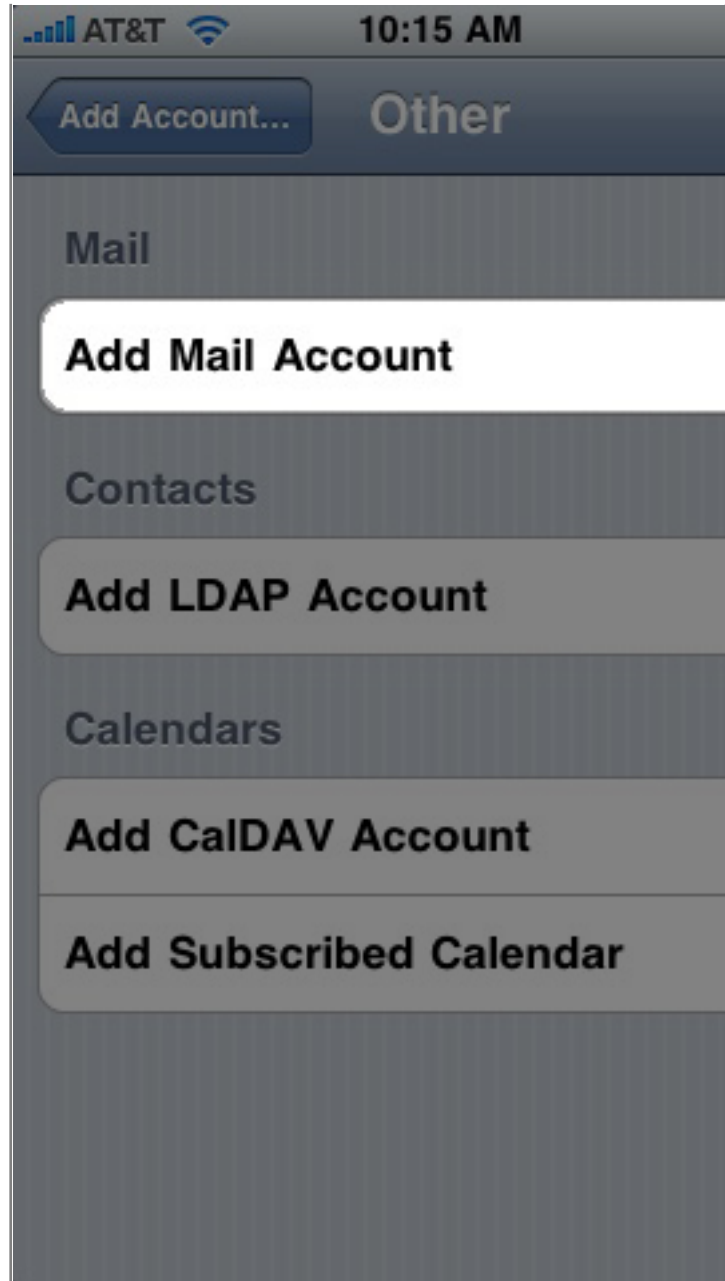
This article explains and shows you how to configure an iPhone with an IMAP e-mail account. This process is simple and should only take a few minutes.

Step #	Task	Screenshot
1.	From the home screen, go to the "Settings" application.	

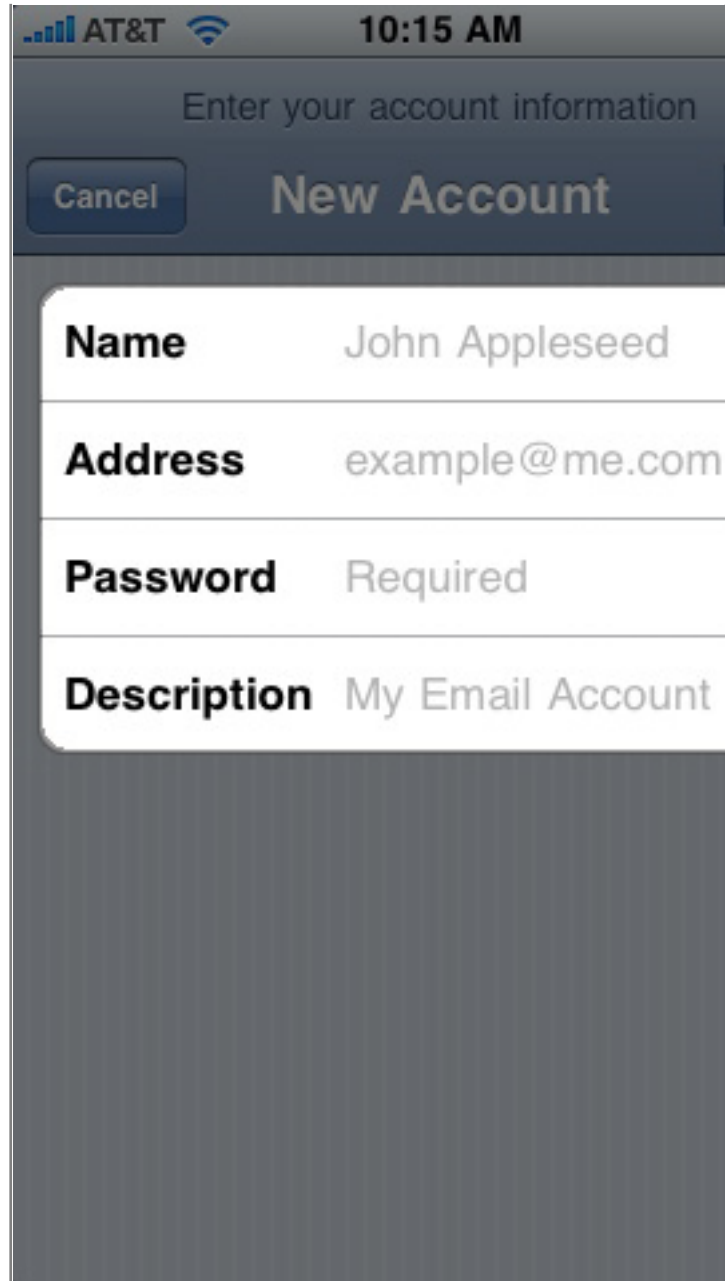
		
2.	On the settings screen, tap <b>Mail, Contacts, Calendars</b> .	

3.	Tap <b>Add Account</b> .
4.	Tap <b>Other</b> .
5.	Tap <b>Add Mail Account</b> .





6. Fill out the **Name, E-mail Address,** and **Password** fields.  
For **Description**, it is best to use your e-mail address.



7. Click **Next**.

8. Tap **IMAP** and fill out the settings completely as follows:

### Incoming Mail Server:

- **Host Name:** *IMAP.NaturalNetworks.COM* (COMPANY.COM should be replaced with your email address following the "@" symbol. For example, if your email address is HanSolo@MFalcon.biz, then your host name would be imap.MFalcon.biz)

- **User name:** Your complete e-mail address
- **Password:** Your password for the account

### Outgoing Mail Server

- **Host Name:** *SMTP.NaturalNetworks.COM*  
(COMPANY.COM should be replaced with your company's domain name. For example, if your e-mail address is HanSolo@MFalcon.biz, then your host name would be smtp.MFalcon.biz)
- **User Name:** Your complete e-mail address
- **Password:** Your password for the account
- **Port:** 587

This is accessible by returning to the **Mail, Contacts, Calendars** screen, selecting your desired account, and then tapping the **Outgoing Mail Server** button. Choose the corresponding entry and verify the port setting below.
