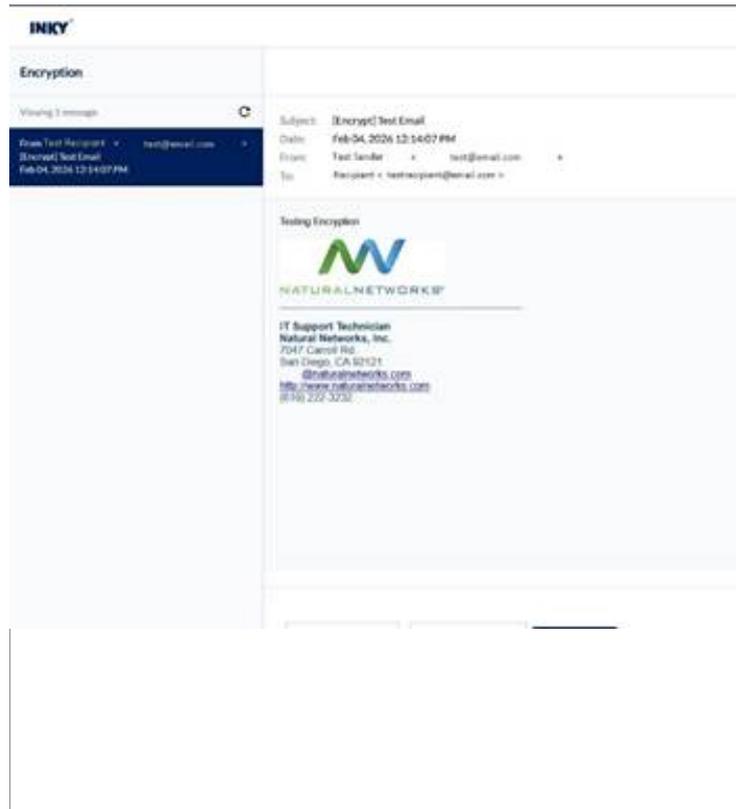

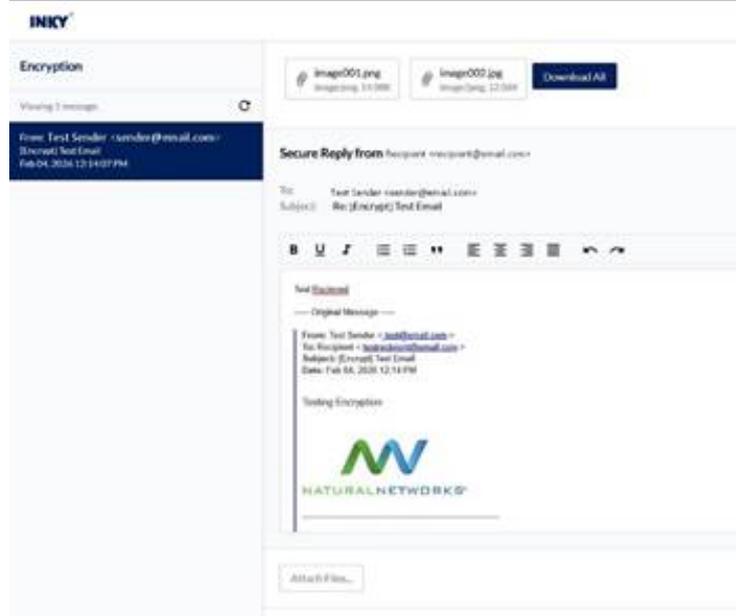

They can now view the encrypted email and can reply from within the portal by clicking the reply button in the upper right-hand corner.



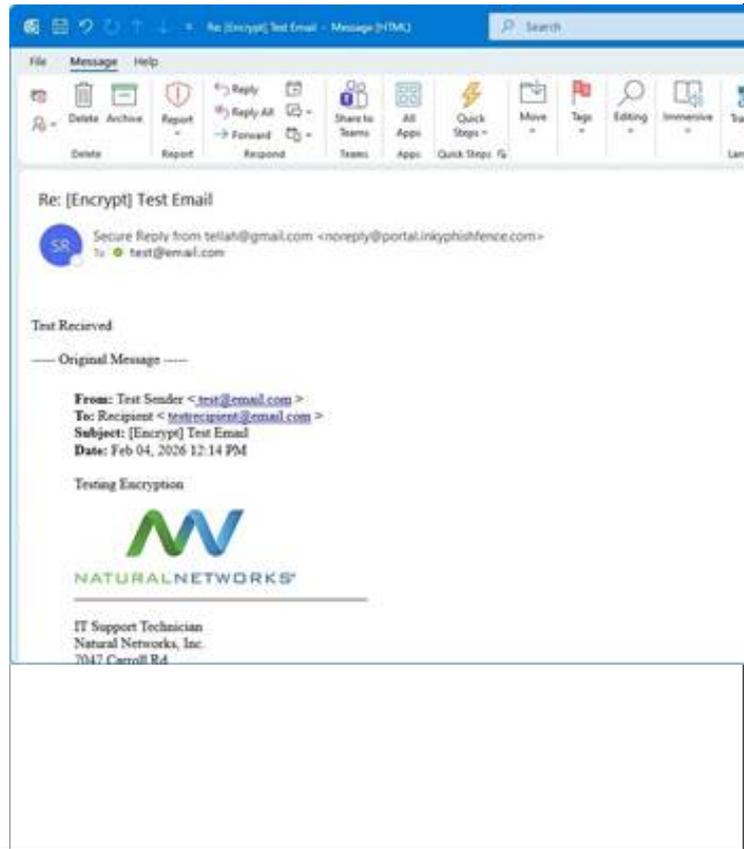
